A Great Family Tradition



'Koorinal', aboriginal for 'home on the hill' was taken over and named by John and Christina Lamont in 1910. Previously the North- West corner of Eunonyharenyha Station, it was a bare block of almost 3000 acres that had been cut off from the rest of the station by the Melbourne to Sydney railway line. They proceeded to develop the property where the house, stables, woolshed and workshop are still in use today.

The farm was not used as a horse stud until after the Second World War, when one of Christina's sons, Colin purchased three broodmares in 1953 that became the foundation of the Koorinal Stud we all know today.

In 1956 Colin bought his first stallion Kerry Piper (GB), who was then joined by Epsom Cup Winner Timor and the stud was transformed from a hobby breeder to a commercial enterprise forming an integral part of the farming business that it is today.

Other notable stallions to stand at Koorinal include Major General, Bless Me, King Hadrian, Majaheed (USA), Mr Henrysee (USA) and Bureaucracy.

Koorinal Stud is owned by Stuart and Penny and is now in its fourth generation of Lamont management, with Angus & Richie both joining the management team.





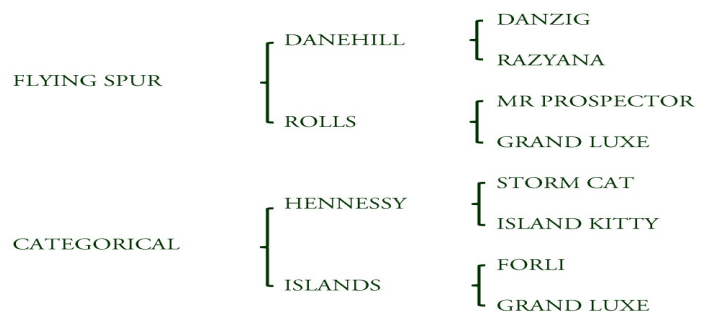

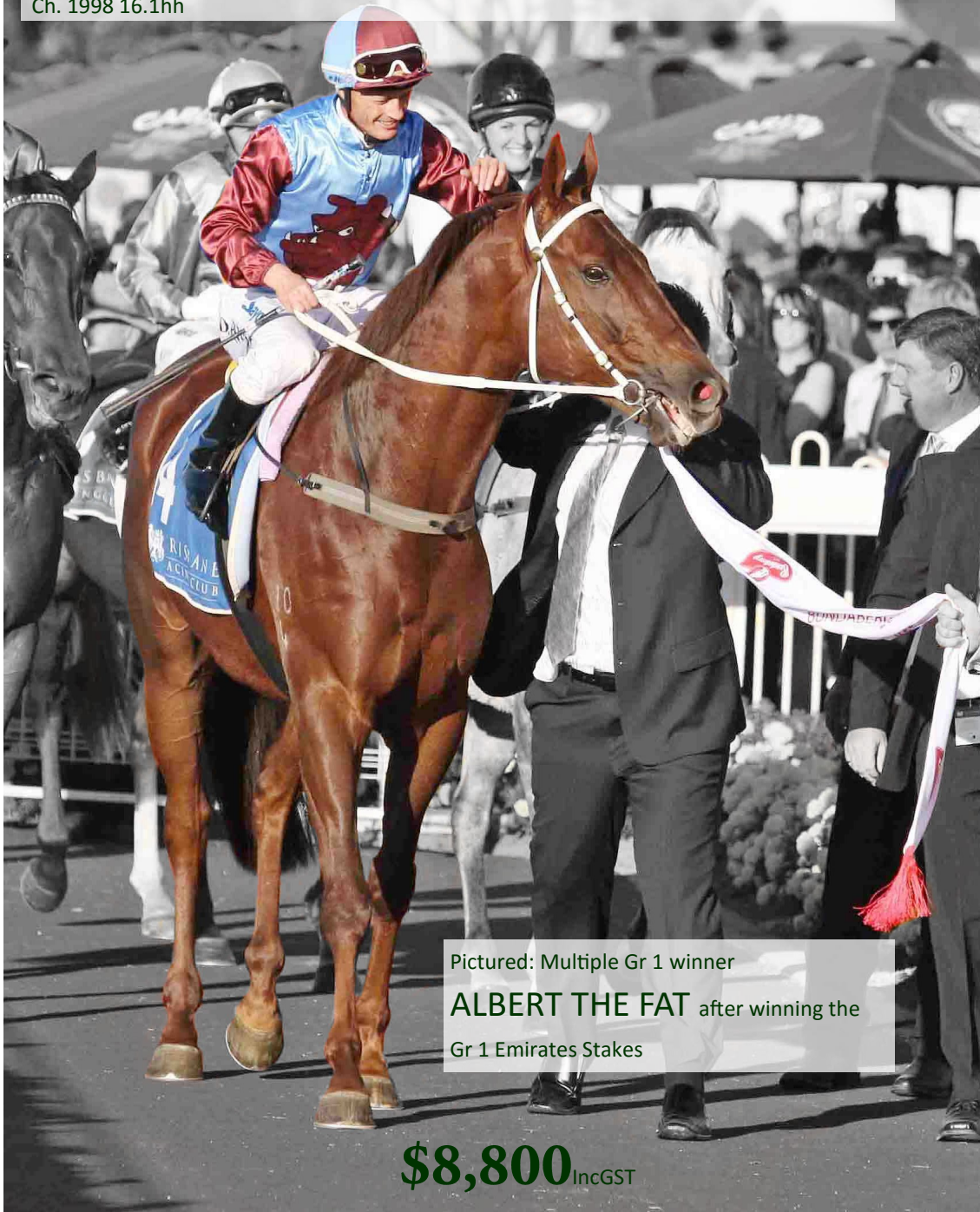

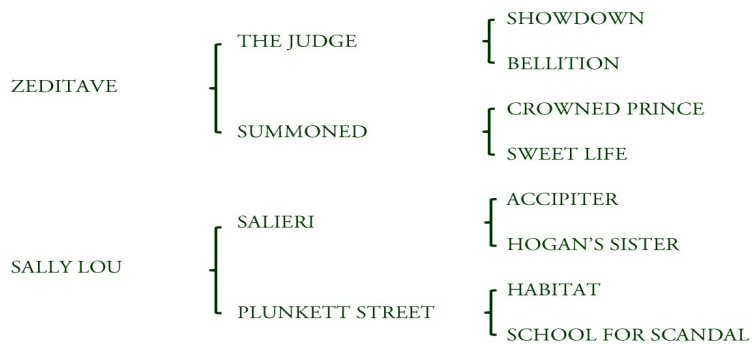


Pictured: Multiple Gr 1 winner

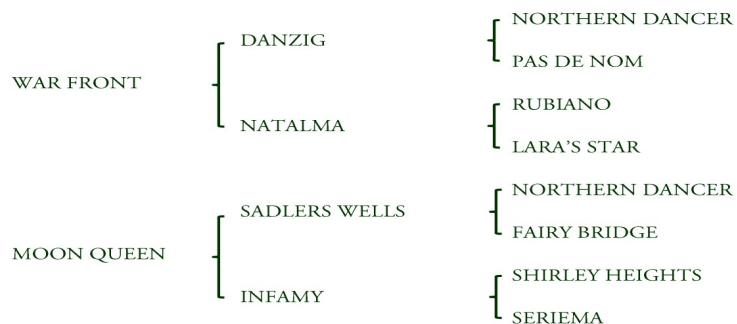

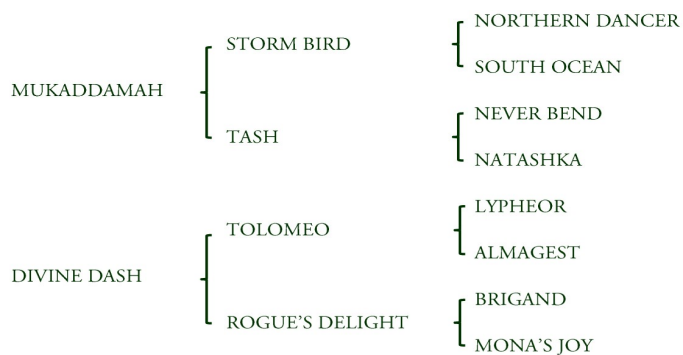
